

Guidelines for Utilizing the Microsoft Teams “HealthPartners” Background Image

To enhance HealthPartners' presence during virtual presentations, we kindly request all volunteers to use the "Microsoft Teams - HealthPartners Background Image." This distinct image helps participants recognize our affiliation and ensures our visibility stands out, especially with two recipients in the GCWCC. Your cooperation in this small endeavor is highly appreciated and contributes to our collective impact.

To change the background photo on Microsoft Teams using the file "Microsoft Teams - HealthPartners Background Image," follow these steps:

1. **Download the Background Image:** Start by downloading the "Microsoft Teams - HealthPartners Background Image" file to a location on your computer. Make sure you remember where you saved it.
2. **Open Microsoft Teams:** Launch the Microsoft Teams application on your computer. Sign in if you haven't already.
3. **Access Your Profile:** Click on your profile picture or initials in the top right corner of the Teams interface. A drop-down menu will appear.
4. **Select "Settings":** From the drop-down menu, select "Settings." This will open the Teams settings panel.
5. **Navigate to "Background Effects":** In the settings panel, you should see a list of options on the left side. Click on "Background effects." This is where you can customize your background.

9. **Adjust and Fine-Tune (Optional):** After applying the background image, you might have options to adjust the blur or focus level, depending on the version of Teams you're using. These options allow you to make your video feed blend seamlessly with the background image.

10. **Start or Join a Meeting:** You're all set! When you start or join a video meeting in Microsoft Teams, your new background image will be displayed instead of your actual surroundings.
